2026 Rules and Guidelines

These are the rules you must follow:

- 1. The writing contest is open to anyone in 4th, 5th or 6th grade and begins on December 15.
- 2. Story is to be 550-700 words long and be text only.
- 3. Include a title, as well as your name, grade, the school you attend and your parents' phone number and email address.
- 4. Submissions must be a word document (Word or Google Doc). No PDFs please.
- 5. Email your entry using a non-school e-mail address to jnelson@papl.info by 11:59pm on February 15.
- 6. This is your story and it can be humor, mystery, fantasy, science fiction or anything you want, but it MUST BE YOUR OWN CREATION.
- 7. Be sure to proofread your work and check for correct spelling and grammar.

A first, second and third place winner will be chosen from three divisions: Fourth Grade, Fifth Grade and Sixth Grade. Winners will be chosen by author Keir Graff. Stories will be judged on creativity and writing skill.

Winners will be announced at the *Short Story Contest Author Talk and Award Ceremony* on Saturday, March 28 at 10am. All writers are invited to attend in person and will also be sent a link for extended family to attend virtually. Each winning writer will attend a meet and greet with Keir Graff to take place immediately following the event (in person). Winning stories will be printed in the *Plainfield Area Public Library Short Story Journal for Grades 4, 5 & 6*.
